AN ORDINANCE FIXING CHARGES FOR UTILITY DEPARTMENTS SERVICE CONNECTIONS AND AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF CHATAM CODE OF ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 51.017 (A) of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Chatham is amended to state as follows:

- (A) For customers located within the corporate limits, a ³/₄ " tap shall be \$750 and a 1" tap shall be \$875 for each connection made to the village water distribution system. For extraterritorial customers the tap fee shall be \$1,000 for either a ³/₄" or 1". For taps other than ³/₄" or 1" the fee shall be based on the current cost of material and labor.
- (B) Water tap fees shall be paid at the time of application for a building permit, except in the case of a new service to an existing building, in which case fee shall be paid upon application for water service.
- (C) If the application for building permit or water service is denied, the fee shall be refunded.

SECTION 2: Section 52.05 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Chatham is amended to state as follows:

Where no line extension or pole setting is required, the installation charge for furnishing service for home or small commercial construction shall be \$20, plus the cost of any material supplied. When it is necessary to extend lines or poles, the customer shall pay the all costs to install and remove such lines. If the extension is more than 100 feet the customer shall pay a deposit of 110% of the estimated cost to install and remove said lines. After construction and removal of the temporary services the Village shall refund to the customer any amount by which the deposit exceeds the actual cost.

SECTION 3: Section 52.06 (A) (1) and (A) (2) and (A) (3) of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Chatham is amended to state as follows:

(A) Any person firm, or corporation applying for the extension of the village distribution system to provide electric service to a single-family dwelling, commercial or business establishment, or trailer or mobile home shall not be granted such service by the village unless and until such applicant shall pay to the village the following fee plus actual cost of wire and equipment required:

 Residential overhead service. Service will be installed from masthead on structure to distribution line by village.

(2) Residential underground service. Service will be installed from meter base to distribution line by customer or property owner. The maintenance of underground service from the meter base to distribution line is the responsibility of the customer or property owner.

(3) Trailer mobile home park service. The owner is to furnish and install 200 ampere meter pedestals at location designated by the village.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is effective immediately. This Ordinance supercedes provisions of all prior ordinances establishing water tap fees, including provisions of Ordinance No. 77-25, Ordinance No. 73-11 and Ordinance No.97-15.
