Ordinance No. 06 - 17

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE UTILITY TAX FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 115.03 (A) of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Chatham is amended to state as follows:

A. There is hereby established in the Village Treasury a designated special fund to be known as the Police and Public Works Utility Tax Fund. Twenty percent (20%) of all taxes imposed by the Village pursuant to Chapter 116 with respect to telecommunications receipts after May 1, 2006, shall be placed by the Village Treasurer in such fund, which shall be segregated from all other funds of the Village.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval as provided by statue. The Clerk shall see to inclusion of this Ordinance in the next update of the Village Code of Ordinances.
