## ORDINANCE NO. 06-43

### AN ORDINANCE REZONING BROWN PROPERTY ON MARKET

WHEREAS, a petition for rezoning was filed by Marjorie Brown requesting the rezoning of the following real property located within the corporate limits of the Village of Chatham, Illinois (the "Property"):

120 Market Street, Chatham, Illinois.

WHEREAS, said petition requested rezoning of the Property from B-1 to R-1A;

WHEREAS, notice was given of the petition, the relief requested therein, the name of the petitioner and the time and place of the hearing by posting on petitioner's land, by publishing a notice thereof on in a newspaper published within the Village of Chatham, Illinois, and by giving written notice by mail to adjacent property owners, all as required in Section VIII (h)(3) of the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Chatham;

WHEREAS, on 7/31/2006 the Village of Chatham Zoning Board of Appeals held a Public Hearing regarding the proposed rezoning and is unanimously recommending the rezoning be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1**: The findings in the preamble hereto are hereby adopted..

**SECTION 2:** The Property is hereby rezoned from its present zoning classification of B-1 to R-1A.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval.
