AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PROPOSAL FOR GIS
UTILITY DEPARTMENT SOFTWARE AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the proposal dated June 29, 2007 from Telvent Miner and Miner for \$10,495 for one ArcFM software seat, one AcrFM software viewer seat, and \$63,568.00 for professional services for Task ID #1 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: The Director is hereby authorized to proceed with expenditures due after October 1, 2007.

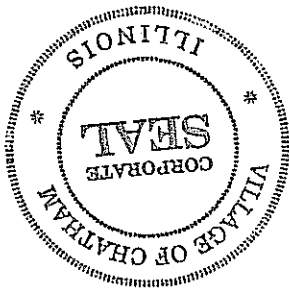


