# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMMENDING THE HOURS OF OPERATION ON SUNDAY FOR PACKAGE LIQUOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMOUN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 111.22 CONDITION OF LICENSE (A)(1) Closing hours, of the Village of Chatham Code of Ordinances shall read as follows:

#### § 111.22 CONDITIONS OF LICENSE.

(A) Closing hours.

(1) Except as provided in divisions (A) (2), (A) (3) and (A) (4) of this section, it shall be unlawful for the holder of any license issued under this subchapter to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the village during the hours of 12:00 midnight to 8:00 a.m.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and approval. The Clerk shall see to its inclusion in the next published update of the Village Code of Ordinances, and shall mail a copy to every liquor licensee in the Village.
