- 11. Free Net Program with the SportMaster System above if village can meet requirements.
- Four hours of on-site consulting for net posts re-setting & grant work with USTA.

Warranty: 2 year on product and workmanship. Crack repair will not prevent cracks from extending or new cracks from appearing.
