AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A
BID FOR LEAF BAGS

WHEREAS; the Village of Chatham sought and obtained bids for 40,000 biodegradable paper yard waste bags a minimum of 30 gallons; and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. the bids were opened and the lowest qualified bidder identified. The staff has reviewed said bids and is recommending the lowest bid from Lowes of \$13,200 or \$.33 per bag.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That the bid from Lowes is hereby accepted.

Section 2: That the appropriate officials be and are hereby directed to sign the necessary forms and issue payment upon demand.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
