## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH BANK OF SPRINGFIELD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** A proposed lease with Bank of Springfield, for the purchase of a 2014 Aerial Truck in the amount of \$111,087 amortized over five years at an interest rate of 1.67%, with an option to purchase the vehicle at the conclusion of the lease for nominal consideration is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2:** The Village President is hereby authorized to execute the lease agreement, and thereafter, the proper officers and employees of the Village are authorized and directed to carry out the lease according to its terms.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage by a 2/3 vote of the corporate authorities, in accordance with Section 11-76-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
