ORDINANCE NO. 15- 50

AN ORDINANCE SETTING VILLAGE BOARD MEETING DATES FOR
CALENDAR YEAR 2016

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham ("Village") is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village have determined it to be in the best interest of the Village to set meeting dates for the Regular Village Board Meeting and Committee of the Whole Meeting for year 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Regular Village Board Meetings. For the year 2016, all Regular Village Board Meetings shall be held on the fourth Tuesday of each month.

Section 3. Committee of the Whole Meetings. For the year 2016, all Regular Village Board Meetings shall be held on the second Tuesday of each month at which time the only action item for formal approval shall be the approval of bills.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 5. Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Effectiveness. This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and publication. The Clerk shall publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, and shall see to its inclusion in the next update of the Village Code of Ordinances.

§ 31.02 COMPENSATION.

(A) The annual salaries of elected officers of the village shall be established by the Board of Trustees as necessary.

~~(B) The annual salaries shall be paid in equal monthly installments commencing on a date as determined by the Board of Trustees.~~

The salary for the Village President and Village Clerk shall be \$339.13 per Village Board meeting attended. Compensation for each of these positions may not exceed \$7,800 per municipal fiscal year.

The salary for the Village Trustees shall be \$130.43 per Village Board meeting attended and \$130.43 per Committee of the Whole attended. If a Village Board meeting and Committee of the Whole meeting occur on the same night, only \$130.43 shall be paid even if both meetings are attended by the trustee. Compensation may not exceed \$6000 per fiscal year.

This Section shall become effective upon the first payroll cycle beginning upon the inauguration of member as follows:

Village President, Village Clerk and three Village Trustees elected and inaugurated to begin terms on or after April, 2017 – the first payroll cycle commencing with assumption of duties in 2017;

Three Village Trustees elected and inaugurated to begin terms on or after April, 2019 – the first payroll cycle commencing with assumption of duties in 2019.
