ORDINANCE NO. 16-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WATER TAP FEE WITHIN VILLAGE OF CHATHAM CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham ("Village") is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, for water service, the Village has adopted a tap fee for connections made to the village water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village believe it is just and proper to provide prior notice to the public of all rate changes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Amendments to 51.018 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Chatham. Title V, Chapter 51, Section 51.018 is hereby amended to state as follows:

51.018 TAP REGULATION; FEE.

- (A) For customers located within the corporate limits, a three-quarter-inch tap shall be \$850 and a one-inch tap shall be \$975 \$1,150 for each connection made to the village water distribution system. For extraterritorial customers the tap fee shall be \$1,000 \$1,200 for either a three-quarter-inch or a one-inch tap. For taps other than three-quarter-inch or one-inch, the fee shall be based on the current cost of material and labor.
- (B) Water tap fees shall be paid at the time of application for a building permit, except in the case of a new service to an existing building, in which case fee shall be paid upon application for water service.
- (C) If an application for building permit or water service is denied, the fee shall be refunded.

Section 3. Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
