### ORDINANCE NO. 16- 40

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A BACKYARD POLE SETTER FROM ALTEC INDUSTRIES, INC.

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham ("Village"), Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 9, 2016, the Village advertised for sealed bids for a backyard pole setter; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received and on June 26, 2016, the sealed bids were opened, with S.D.P. Manufacturing, Inc. bidding \$152,858.00 and Altec Industries, Inc. bidding \$141,475.00; and

WHEREAS, Village staff recommends the low bid from Altec Industries, Inc. be accepted and the Village Manager authorized to purchase the back yard pole setter as bid.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, County of Sangamon, as follows:

- **Section 1.** Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.
- Section 2. Approval of Bid. The Board of Trustees of the Village hereby accept the bid of Altec Industries, Inc., in the amount of \$141,475.00 for the purchase of a new Altec model DB37 backyard digger derrick with trailer and authorizes the Village Manager to execute any necessary documents to effectuate said purchase.
- **Section 3**. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to

the greatest extent permitted by law.

**Section 4.** Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**Section 5**. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


