AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ENGAGEMENT WITH FLOWERS SANITATION FOR THE USE OF DUMPSTERS FOR THE VILLAGE'S FALL CLEANUP WEEKEND

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village is planning to hold its annual Fall Cleanup Weekends on the weekends of October 1, 2016 and October 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Village issued a request for bids on September 1, 2016, for dumpsters and two vendors responded, with Flowers Sanitation proposing a price of \$300.00 per dumpster for trash and no cost for scrap metal dumpsters and Allied Waste proposing a price of \$525.00 per dumpster for trash and \$215 per dumpster for scrap metal; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to utilize the bid from Flowers Sanitation for the provision of dumpsters at its Fall Cleanup Weekends.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Authority to Contract with Flower Sanitation for the Provision of Dumpsters. The Village Manager is authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate the purchase of dumpsters from Flower Sanitation for the provision of dumpsters for the Village's Fall Cleanup Weekends.

Section 3. Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
