ORDINANCE NO. 19-

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH ALL WEATHER COURTS FOR THE CONVERSION OF THREE TENNIS COURTS INTO EIGHT PICKLE BALL COURTS

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham ("Village"), Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village solicited a proposal from All Weather Courts ("AWC") for the conversion of three tennis courts into eight pickle ball courts; and

WHEREAS, AWC proposed making the conversions at a cost of labor and material in the amount of \$40,540; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds it to be in the best interests of the Village to waive any formal bidding requirements, as this is a unique service and there are limited companies in the area that provide the court conversions desired, and award the contract AWC in the amount of \$40,540.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, County of Sangamon, as follows:

- **Section 1.** Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.
- Section 2. Approval of Contract. The Board of Trustees of the Village hereby approve contract with All Weather Courts, in the amount of \$40,540, for the conversion of three tennis courts into eight pickle ball courts. The Village Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents to effectuate the contract, after receipt of the pledged \$20,000 in contributions from local groups in support of the project.

Section 3. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

- 1. Remove 3 sets of net posts, nets and straps return to village.
- 2. Lay-out 8 pickle ball courts.
- 3. Supply and install 8 sets of sleeves.
- 4. Pressure wash 3 tennis courts.
- 5. Fill low areas. (no guarantee of total removal).
- 6. Fill cracks with acrylic crack compound, NO Warranty on acrylic crack repair. Warranted comprehensive crack treatment is an option below.
- 7. Apply one coats of Acrylic Resurfacer.
- 8. Apply two coats of Acrylic Color in 3-tone blue, light blue and green.
- 9. Lay-out and stripe per USPBA specifications.
- 10. Supply and install 3 dividing net systems.
- 11. Supply and install 8 sets of pickle ball posts, nets.

OPTION 1: Comprehensive Crack Treatment, supply and install Riteway Crack Treatment to 400 lineal feet of cracks. \$7200.00 additional to pricing below. 2 year warranty on cracks. Will not prevent new cracks from forming or existing cracks from extending.
