AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOW BID FOR REPAIR WORK ON GARVEY LANE

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (“Village”) is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village requested bids to remove and replace a portion of Garvey Lane with Portland Concrete Cement Pavement and improved Aggregate Base Course; and

WHEREAS, the Village solicited bids in accordance with Illinois law for proposals from companies willing and able to provide the services requested, and the Village opened all bids on November 2, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the bid documents made clear that the Village reserved the right to accept or reject any and/or all parts of the bid; and,

WHEREAS, the Village received lowest responsible bid from Kinney Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$27,724.00 for repair work on Garvey Lane as further described in the bid attached hereto as **Exhibit A**; and,

WHEREAS, the Village intends to accept the lowest responsible bid from Kinney Contractors, Inc; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village believe it is in the best interest of the Village to accept the bid from Kinney Contractors, Inc. as attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Acceptance of Bid. The Village hereby approves bid from Kinney Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$27,724.00 as further described in the bid packet attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. Any and all bids and parts thereof not explicitly approved by this Ordinance are hereby rejected. The Village authorizes the Village Manager and/or Village President, or designee of either, to execute any documents necessary to complete the purchases contemplated therein.

Section 3. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

EXHIBIT A

GARVEY LANE BID FROM KINNEY CONTRACTORS, INC.

Village of Chatham Street Repair Bid- Garvey Lane

The Village of Chatham will be accepting sealed bids, until 11:00 Am Monday October XX, 2020, to remove and replace a portion of Garvey Lane with Portland Concrete Cement Pavement (PCC) and improved Aggregate Base Course. All Bids must be hand delivered or mailed in sealed envelopes and clearly marked "Garvey Lane Bid" ATTN: Shane Hill, 117 E. Mulberry, Chatham IL 62629. This work shall be performed in accordance with the Illinois Department of Transportation's Standard Specification for Road and Bridge Construction and all materials furnished shall be from an IDOT approved source, for which documentation must be provided by the successful bidder prior to construction. This work shall be paid for at a lump sum price for the following: Removal and disposal of 204 square yards of existing 6" bituminous pavement, excavation to proposed subgrade depth, mechanical compaction of existing subgrade, furnish and place 4" CA-6 aggregate base course Type B, drill and epoxy 18" long #5dia. tie bars at 30" spacing along existing curb and gutter, furnish and place 204 square yards of Class PP-2 concrete pavement with saw cut contraction joints at pavement centerline and 15 foot joint spacing, road closure and sidewalk closure barricades in accordance with applicable IDOT Highway Standards. All work shall be completed within two weeks of initial roadway closure. The Village reserves the right to accept or refuse any or all bids. - Engineering or engineering fees are excluded from this proposal.
- Any subgrade repair or remediation or soil amending has been excluded from our proposal. i.e. lime stabilization or modification and cement stabilization or modification.
- Proposal excludes any specialty insurance. i.e. Railroad or Builders Risk.
- All QC/QA and compaction testing by others.
- Includes winter concrete and winter protection.
- Ground heating or heaters are excluded.
- This proposal excludes any earthwork including any fine grading or backfilling.
- Subgrade will be approved by KCI prior to pavement or aggregate placement.
- This quote and our written conditions attached will become a part of the subcontract documents.
- Traffic Control is included and shall consist of a BLR-22 (Road Closure).
- This proposal excludes any handling, hauling or disposing of any hazardous or non-hazardous materials.
- This proposal includes 1 mobilization. Additional mobilizations will be \$1,000.00 per each piece of Equipment.
- Payment terms and conditions are as follows; net payments due (30) days from date of invoice. Late or delinquent payments may result in monthly a finance charge of 1.5%.
- Proposal is valid for 30 days after bid date.
