ORDINANCE NUMBER 21-5

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII OF THE VILLAGE CODE
REGARDING ROLL- DUMPSTER PLACEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (hereinafter “Village”) is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 70 of the Village Code regulates General Provision of the Traffic Code of the Village; and,

WHEREAS, Section 70.01 (F) of the Village Code regulates the parking of motor vehicles and other pieces of equipment on public streets in the Village; and,

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend its regulations to add regulations on the placement of roll-off dumpsters within roadway rights-of-way within the Village to reflect the changes as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Amendment to Village Code. Section (F) of Chapter 70 Section 70.01 of the Village Code shall be amended as follows (added; ~~deleted~~):

Chapter 70: General Provisions

§ 70.01 PARKING.

...

(F) (1) No person shall park a truck, except those licensed by the State of Illinois with a B license classification (8,000 lbs or less), a bus having a rated seating capacity of 12 or more passengers, farm equipment, construction equipment,

trailers or semitrailers on any public street within the village, for a period of four consecutive hours or more.

(2) No person shall park a utility trailer, recreational vehicles or trailers, boats or boat trailers on any public street within the village, for a period of four consecutive hours or more.

(3) No person, firm or corporation shall place a roll-off dumpster of any cubic dimension within the roadway right-of-way boundaries of any street within the corporate limits of the village.

Section 3. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effectiveness. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
