ORDINANCE NO. 21 - ____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VILLAGE EXPENDITURES PENDING ADOPTION OF AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (hereinafter "Village") is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the appropriation ordinance for fiscal year May 1, 2021 to April 30, 2022, has not been enacted by the corporate authorities of the Village; and

WHEREAS, pending the passage of such annual appropriation ordinance, the corporate authorities of the Village have authority to and may make any necessary expenditure upon the basis of the appropriations of the preceding year, as authorized by Section 8-1-7 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. <u>Authorization</u>. Pending the passage of the annual appropriation ordinance for fiscal year May 1, 2021 to April 30, 2022, heads of departments or other agencies of the Village are hereby authorized, beginning May 1, 2021, to make necessary expenditures for the support thereof upon the basis of the appropriations of the preceding fiscal year.

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. <u>Repeal and Savings Clause</u>. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 5. <u>Effectiveness</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law on May 1, 2021.
