ORDINANCE NO. 22- 16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (“Village”), Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing municipality operating under and pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of each municipality may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities, with such fines or penalties as may be deemed proper; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, grants municipalities with a population less than 500,000 the authority to sell and dispose of personal property it determines, by a simple majority of the corporate authorities, to be no longer useful and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Village owns a 2006 Chevrolet Impala with VIN #2G1WS551169353454, a Tonneau Cover from a 2016 Dodge Ram 1500 short bed that have nominal value and are no longer of any use to the Village and/or are obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham find that this equipment is no long useful or necessary and shall be disposed of as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are incorporated herein by this reference as if specifically stated in full.

Section 2. Disposition of Property. The Village Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to sell or dispose of the 2006 Chevrolet Impala with VIN #2G1WS551169353454 and a Tonneau Cover from a 2016 Dodge Ram 1500 short bed.

Section 3. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effectiveness. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
