

ORDINANCE NO. 23-43

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM'S INDEPENDENCE BOULEVARD ELECTRIC SUBSTATION 'THE SHANE HILL SUBSTATION'

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham (hereinafter "Village") is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village owns and operates an electric substation at 125 Independence Blvd. within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Shane Hill was continuously employed by the Village from October 28, 1986 until his retirement date of December 8, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Shane Hill became a Lineman Apprentice in May of 1992, a Line Foreman in July of 1994, and a General Foreman in May of 2008; and

WHEREAS, because of Shane Hill's lengthy employment period and extensive involvement with the design, construction, and upkeep of the Village's electric distribution system, the community has greatly benefited; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village believe it is in the best interest of the Village to formally recognize the extensive contribution of Shane Hill to the Village and enshrine his legacy in the history of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, County of Sangamon, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made part of the Ordinance as if fully set forth in Section 1.

Section 2. Naming of Independence Blvd. Substation. The Village Board hereby officially names the Substation located at 125 Independence Blvd. as The Shane Hill Substation and directs staff to make any necessary signage changes to reflect the new name.

Section 3. Incorporation of Resolution 52-23. The Village President and Village Board hereby incorporate Resolution 52-23: Designating December 8, 2023, as Shane Hill Day in the Village of Chatham within.

Section 4. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 5. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any

rights, actions, or causes of actions which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this ordinance.


Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


