RESOLUTION NO. 2-76

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to enact regulations relating to procedures for the issuance of building permits in conjunction with the approval of architectural committees in subdivisions, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS:

That the following procedures will be followed in issuing building permits:

- (1) Applicants for Building Permits must first secure the approval of the architectural committee for their respective subdivision.
- (2) Upon submitting the plans with the architectural committee's approval thereon to the zoning administrator, the application will then be considered.
- (3) The Board will hold the architectural committee responsible for compliance with the covenants by the builder.

That the President of the Village is authorized and directed to prepare and sign a letter to subdivision developers in Chatham informing them of the requirements of this resolution; and that the Village Clerk is authorized and directed to mail by first class mail a copy of such letter to each known subdivision developer operating in the Village of Chatham.
