RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Village of Chatham, located in the County of Sangamon, State of Illinois, wishes to locate, construct and maintain a 3/4-inch copper service located approximately 15 feet from edge of pavement on the north side of Walnut Street and approximately 150 feet west of the G. M. & O. railroad tracks, which by law comes under the jurisdiction and control of Sangamon County Highway Department of State of Illinois, and

WHEREAS, a permit from said Highway Department is required before said work can be legally undertaken by said Village of Chatham Water Department: now

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village of Chatham, County of Sangamon, State of Illinois.

First: That we do hereby request from the Sangamon County Highway Department, State of Illinois, a permit authorizing the Village of Chatham Water Department to proceed with the work herein described.

Second: That we hereby pledge the good faith of the people of the Village of Chatham and guarantee that all work shall be performed in accordance with the conditions of the permit to be granted by the Highway Department and to hold the Highway Department harmless on account of any damage that may occur to persons or property during the prosecution of such work, and assume all liability for damages to persons or property due to accidents or otherwise by reason of the work which is to be performed under the provision of said permit.

Third: That we hereby state that the proposed work is to be performed by the employees of the Village of Chatham Water Department.

Fourth: That the proper officers of the Village of Chatham are hereby instructed and authorized to sign said permit in behalf of the people of the Village of Chatham.
