

RESOLUTION 18-78

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE OF CHATHAM
located in the County of SANGAMON, State of Illinois, wishes to con-
struct and maintain sanitary sewer crossings on Polecat Creek and an unnamed
tributary Southeast of the Village all of which discharge into Lake Springfield

which by law comes under the jurisdiction and control of the Department of
Transportation of the State of Illinois, Division of Water Resources, and

WHEREAS, a permit from said Department is required before said work can be
legally undertaken by said VILLAGE OF CHATHAM
: now

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the VILLAGE OF CHATHAM
County of SANGAMON, State of Illinois.

FIRST: That we do hereby request from the Department of Transportation,
State of Illinois, Division of Water Resources, a permit authorizing the
VILLAGE OF CHATHAM to proceed with the work herein described.

SECOND: That we hereby pledge the good faith of the
VILLAGE OF CHATHAM

and guarantee that all work shall be performed in accordance with the conditions
of the conditions of the permit to be granted by the Department of Transportation
of the State of Illinois and to hold the State of Illinois, Department of Trans-
portation, Division of Water Resources, harmless on account of any damages that
may occur to persons or property during the prosecution of such work, and assume
all liability for damages to persons or property due to accidents or otherwise by
reason of the work which is to be performed under the provisions of said permit.

THIRD: That the proper officers of the VILLAGE OF CHATHAM
are hereby instructed and authorized
to sign said permit in behalf of the VILLAGE OF CHATHAM.
