

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM is advised that certain petitions were filed with the Board of Managers of the Chatham Township Community Building on August 12, 1980 requesting that the Board call a referendum on the question of a sale of the Township Community Building to the Village of Chatham; and

WHEREAS, the said Board of Managers has refused to call a referendum as required by statute therefore; and

WHEREAS, certain of the petitioners have requested the Circuit Court of Sangamon County to issue a writ of mandamus to compel the Board of Managers to call such referendum; and

WHEREAS, the said petitioners have requested the Village of Chatham to join said lawsuit as a necessary party and to indicate to the Court the willingness of the Village to pay the price of \$10.00, as stipulated in the said petitions, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Village of Chatham shall join the action heretofore described and filed to compel the conduct of a referendum on the question of the sale of the Chatham Township Community Building to the Village for the sum of \$10.00.

Section 2. The Village attorney is authorized to represent the Village in said action and to take such action as may be necessary and appropriate to join same and to represent to the Court that the Village will pay such price when and if such referendum is returned in favor of such sale.
