

A G R E E M E N T

THIS AGREEMENT, made at Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, this 27 day of March, 1984, by and between the Village of Chatham, Illinois, hereinafter called the VILLAGE and Sangamon County, Illinois, hereinafter called the COUNTY:

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE and the COUNTY are desirous of improving County Highway Route 40, FAUS Route 8146, Walnut Street, in Chatham by constructing a new single span precast prestressed concrete deck beam bridge over Polecat Creek and approximately 750 feet of new approach roadway 22 feet in width and all appurtenances thereto; and,

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE and the COUNTY are also desirous of improving FAUS Route 8147, Downing Drive, by replacing the existing drainage structure over Polecat Creek with a larger structure of sufficient size to eliminate serious flooding problems; and,

WHEREAS, FAUS funds will be available to pay for a maximum 75% of the cost of the Downing Drive Structure with the VILLAGE and COUNTY each providing one half of the remaining matching costs, each share estimated to be \$30,000; and,

WHEREAS, Paragraphs 5-501, 5-502, and 5-504 of Chapter 121 of the Illinois Revised Statutes permits and encourages cooperation between municipalities and counties in the joint construction of bridges providing mutual benefits; and,

WHEREAS, said PROJECTS will be of benefit to both the VILLAGE and the COUNTY; and,

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE and the COUNTY wish to cooperate in the construction of said PROJECTS.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein set forth, it is agreed that:

THE COUNTY SHALL:

1. Prepare or cause to be prepared all plans, specifications and estimates for the PROJECTS and will perform all construction engineering on the PROJECTS at no cost to the VILLAGE.
2. Be responsible for all costs and work relative to construction of the new bridge on County Highway Route 40 over Polecat Creek estimated to be \$141,000.
3. Be responsible for one half (estimated to be 12.5%) of the matching cost of the new structure on Downing Drive over Polecat Creek, said cost estimated to be \$30,000.
4. Furnish the resident engineer for the FAUS resurfacing project on Park Street at no cost to the VILLAGE.

THE VILLAGE SHALL:

1. Upon completion of the new structure on County Highway Route 40, over Polecat Creek, assume jurisdiction of Walnut Street from its Intersection with Illinois Route 4 to its Intersection with Gordon Drive.
2. Be responsible for acquiring all right of way and easements for the Downing Drive project at no cost to the COUNTY and pay all costs relative to the acquisition of said right of way.
3. Be responsible for relocation of all utilities, if required, for the Downing Drive Structure at no cost to the COUNTY.
4. Be responsible for one half (estimated to be 12.5%) of the matching cost of the new structure on Downing Drive over Polecat Creek, said cost estimated to be \$30,000.
