Experience: I joined Ill. Dept. of Transportation upon graduation from Univ. of Missouri-Rolla in Jan. 1973. With IDOT I worked for the Bureau of Design, Construction, and Local Roads and Streets. With the most of the time being spent in construction.

In Oct. 1978 I went to work for the Sangamon County Highway Dept. From 1978 I worked as Traffic Engineer until June 1979 when I became Maintenance Field Engineer. In July 1981 I was promoted to Resident Engineer for urban projects.

In Jan. 1985, to present, I was promoted to Assistant Superintendent of Highways. As Assistant I have been in charge of all the daily activities of the Highway Dept. These activities include yearly budgeting, equipment purchases, fiscal year programming, maintenance of roadways, construction of new roadways, design of county and township projects, and equipment maintenance.

In July 1986, I was asked to be Acting Supt. of Highways until a replacement could be found. I held this position until Feb. 1987 when the present Supt. of Highways was hired.

In sixteen (16) years as a Civil Engineer I have had the opportunity to work from the design stage all the way to the daily maintenance of roadways, from the original ideal to the final budget. With this background it makes daily decisions easier.

As a Resident:

I have served on Village of Chatham Water Tower Committee, Ball Chatham School Dist. Committees, I have been with the Chatham Jaycees since 1981. With the Jaycees I have served as Director, Treas., V.P., and as President. I was recognized as "Outstanding Local President" by the Ill. Jaycees.
