

RESOLUTION NO. 20-92


WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, in its regular meeting on June 14, 1977 enacted Ordinance No. 77-16 regulating the use of the Chatham Village Park and, by implication, all other public parks and space in Chatham: and;

WHEREAS, that ordinance provided in Section 5 that the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham may by formal action grant specific exception in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Chatham.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois has considered the application of the Chatham American Legion for the use of the Chatham Village Park from June 20, 1993 through June 27, 1993 and has concluded that such use would be in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Chatham; and that the provisions of Ordinance No. 77-16 referred to above, shall not apply to said use for the period specifically described above. Rules and guidelines for the specific operation of the Homecoming Festival shall be agreed upon by resolution by the Village of Chatham at a date prior to the festival.
