A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING DEVELOPMENT
OF A PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT SYTEM


Whereas, the Federal Highway Administration and the Illinois Department of Transportation are implementing a new policy promoting the development of Pavement Management Systems by local agencies for federal aid roadways under their jurisdiction; and

Whereas, the policy requires a Pavement Management System in order for local agencies to be eligible for federal transportation funding for maintenance and pavement preservation projects; and

Whereas, the Village of Chatham is requesting federal transportation funds for the Plummer Blvd resurfacing project which is classified as a pavement preservation project.

Now therefore, the Village of Chatham commits to develop a Pavement Management System on the federal aid road system under its jurisdiction if the Plummer Blvd project is awarded federal transportation funds.

This Resolution is effective upon passage and approval as provided by law.


