


RESOLUTION NO. 41-13

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE FRIENDS OF THE PARK
USE OF THE CHATHAM COMMUNITY PARK FOR
LIGHT UP THE PARK


WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, in its regular meeting on June 14, 1977 enacted Ordinance No. 77-16 regulating the use of the Chatham Village Park and, by implication, all other public parks and space in Chatham: and;

WHEREAS, that ordinance provided in Section 5 that the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, by formal action grant specific exception in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Chatham.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois has considered the application of the Friends of the Park for the use of the Chatham Community Park on the following dates: 11/29, 11/30, 12/6, 12/7, 12/13, 12/14, 12/20, and 12/21, and has concluded that such use would be in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Chatham, including the temporary closing of the Community Park road for the event; and that the provisions of Ordinance No. 77-16 referred to above, shall not apply to said use for the period specifically described above.
