RESOLUTION NO. 07-22

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Village of Chatham ("Village") is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village requested bids for three trucks to be used as police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Village approved Resolution 44-21 approving the purchase of three Ram 1500 SSV pickup trucks or similar vehicles at a price not to exceed \$122,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, because of a shortage of vehicles available due to COVID-19, the Village was unable to purchase the vehicles last year; and,

WHEREAS, the Village solicited sealed bids for a police vehicles, with notice published in the Chatham Clarion on January 19, 2022 and bids opened on February 1, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the Village received a single bid from Victory Lane for three 2021 Dodge Durango police vehicles at a price of \$104,865.00; and,

WHEREAS, intends to accept a quote from Victory Lane for the purchase of three Dodge

Durangos as further described in the Bid attached hereto as Exhibit A; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Police Department had budgeted \$122,000.00 for the purchase of these vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village believe it is in the best interest of the Village to accept the quote from Victory Lane as attached hereto;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Acceptance of Quote. The Village hereby approves the quote from Victory Lane in the amount of \$104,865.00 as further described in the attached Exhibit A. Any and all quotes and parts thereof not explicitly approved by this Ordinance are hereby rejected. The Village authorizes the Village Manager and/or Village President, or designee of either, to execute any documents necessary to complete the purchases contemplated therein.

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Resolution and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Chatham prior to the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
