

**RESOLUTION NO. 30-23**

**A RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO THE EXTENSION OF THE LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY DECLARATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Chatham (“Village”) is an Illinois Municipal Corporation existing and operating under the Illinois Municipal Code and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Village Code Section 92.06 (A)(1), the Village President has the authority to declare a local disaster emergency; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Village Code Section 92.06 (B), a local disaster emergency may not continue in excess of seven days except with the consent of the Village Board of Trustees; and

**WHEREAS**, a local disaster emergency was declared by the Village President on June 29, 2023, a copy of which Village of Chatham State of Emergency and Emergency Declaration is attached hereto as **Exhibit A** (“Emergency Declaration”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board believes it to be in the best interest of the Village to consent to the extension of Emergency Declaration until 11:59 p.m. on July 25, 2023.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2.02, the Village may call an emergency meeting and give notice as soon as practicable; and,

**WHEREAS**, notice of the emergency meeting was posted at the Village Hall and on the Village’s website on July 5, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the emergency meeting was provide to the Chatham Clarion on July 5, 2023; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chatham, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

**Section 2. Extension of the Emergency Declaration.** The Village Board of Trustees hereby consents to the extension of the Emergency Declaration until 11:59 p.m. on July 25, 2023.


**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

**WHEREAS**, The Village of Chatham has suffered from a Severe Wind-Related Event that occurred on June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at approximately 12:10pm (CST).

**WHEREAS**, extensive damage was caused to public and private property, roads, bridges, homes, businesses, utilities, and other public and private facilities; and


**WHEREAS**, emergency response operations continue throughout the village and are severely straining all responding agencies and the emergency operations plan is in effect; and


**WHEREAS**, the cost and magnitude of responding to and recovering from the impact of this event is far in excess of the village's available resources;

**WHEREAS**, these conditions do create a "State of Emergency" according to local and state statutes;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the President of the Village of Chatham has declared a state of emergency on the behalf of Village of Chatham, and will execute for and on behalf of the Village of Chatham, the expenditure of emergency funds from all available sources, the invoking of mutual aid agreements, and the requesting assistance from the Sangamon County.
